Group Study Exchange is Seeking Leaders and Team Members



This coming year will offer an opportunity for Rotarian team leaders to guide four-member teams of non-Rotarian young professionals on month-long exchanges with District 4300 in Southern Peru and District 2520-Japan, including the city of Sendai. The exchange with Peru is a general exchange, calling for a team from various professions. With Japan, we will have a Single Focus Exchange with the interest area being “renewable energy”. The team leader must be employed in or have a demonstrated interest in the field while team members must have at least two years of occupational experience in renewable energy. Rotarians are encouraged to apply for the team leader position and to recruit professionals who are between the ages of 25 and 40 for the teams.
